

New South Knoxville restaurant, Burger Boys, opens on Chapman Highway

Andre Bryant of Knoxville has opened a new restaurant on Chapman Highway offering burgers, chicken livers and gizzards, and free french fries.

Burger Boys is a drive-thru only restaurant that occupies the former Cuppy's Coffee location at 2400 Chapman Highway.

The restaurant opened on Thursday. It's a product of Bryant falling in love with the food industry after he worked at Wendy's as a teenager.

"I started at 15 years old working for Wendy's. I would work for Wendy's for 13 years, and I started on fries and went all the way up to franchise trainer," Bryant said.

"Throughout the years, I was a franchise trainer in New York for Wendy's, and...just early on when I decided to work for Wendy's, I started to fall in love with it, and I just decided one day just looking at their operations and things to that degree, I wanted to open up my own company."

Burger Boys' menu

Burger Boys' menu features several varieties of burgers named after Bryant's sons.

"I named all the burgers after my boys," said Bryant. "That's why we're the Burger Boys."

The burgers include the Kobe, Lil Dom, Lil Dre, Dante, Big Dom and Vol burger. All of them are half-pound burgers except for the Big Dom, which is a pound, according to Bryant.

Burger Boys' menu also has chicken livers and gizzards by the pint or quart, chicken wings and sandwiches, perch and catfish sandwiches, white rice, mashed potatoes, green beans, gravy, cheesecake and sweet potato pie, according to a post on its Facebook page.

It also features free french fries with any burger or sandwich.

Its hours are 11 a.m.-8 p.m. Monday-Thursday, 11 a.m.-10 p.m. Fridays and Saturdays, and noon-6 p.m. Sundays.
